



## A PERSONAL GUIDED TOUR OF THE PORT OF BOSTON

Have you ever wondered how your precious cargo is received and handled in Boston? Are you aware that you have all-water shipping options right to your neighborhood? NELABC and Massport invite you to explore the Port of Boston and learn how you might improve your business.

On Thursday, May 12, 2005 we are offering our first personal guided tour of Conley Terminal.

Tour begins at 10:00 a.m. at the Massport Maritime Offices on the Fish Pier in South Boston. From there, you will board a bus/van and make your way to Conley Terminal via the waterfront. En route, you will briefly visit the new Seafood District, Black Falcon Passenger Terminal and International Cargo Port.

Arriving at Conley Container Terminal you will see first hand how containers are accepted and processed into the terminal. You will meet the clerk staff and Massport operations folks. You will tour the yard and observe working vessel operations, learn about new port security procedures and, if time permits, visit with US Customs.

Following the tour, you are invited to join us in a question and answer period over a Massport-sponsored lunch at a local South Boston restaurant.

Tour will conclude at approximately 2:00 p.m. Please dress in comfortable casual clothing. No open-toed shoes. A photo ID is required to attend.
